

That's why we created Colorbiotics Tote Recycling: to make it easier than ever to get rid of empty totes and make your business more sustainable while you're at it. Our dedicated recycling facility will accept mulch colorant totes from any brand and reprocesses them to make new ones, saving money and reducing waste. All you have to do is schedule your pick up and we'll take care of the rest.

Guidelines for recycling:

- Colorant residue can remain inside the totes, but other debris is unacceptable.
- Customers will receive fines up to \$1,000 if valves are not closed and leakage occurs.
- Foreign materials on top or inside of totes will not be permitted and may result in fines up to \$1,000 per occurrence.
- Only return totes that are not bent or broken.
- Loads containing less than 70% usable cages will be fined up to \$1,000.*
- Customers who return totes at their expense will be credited \$15/good tote.

^{*} Customers who return a load with less than 70% usable totes will have to take additional steps to ensure quality for their next load. This may include verifying the quality and number of totes with a phone call or pictures.











How to stack totes on a trailer:

- 60 tote minimum required on return loads.
- All tote valves must be closed.
- Stack totes with valve facing out.
- Totes should be stacked two-high.
- Cannot stack two 330-gallon totes on flatbeds.
